Conditions of Entry & Judging Framework



Eligibility:

- Open to youth aged 12–18 living in the Gunnedah Shire and surrounding areas.
- Entries can be submitted in one of two categories: Visual Artwork or Short-Form Video.

1. Visual Artwork:

- · Must reflect at least one of the project's themes: Hope, Connection, Strength, Love, Growth, Community.
- · Any 2D medium accepted.
- · Submit a high-quality digital scan or photo (minimum 300dpi).

2. Short-Form Video:

- · Create a 15–60 second video exploring one or more themes (animation, dance, spoken word, storytelling, collage, etc.).
- · Must be original, respectful, and appropriate.
- Upload to a parent/teen's account, tag #ConadillyCanvas, and submit via the entry form with a short description.
- · Videos will not be reposted without written permission. Winning videos may be reinterpreted visually within the mural.

Judging Criteria:

- · Relevance to theme(s)
- Creativity and originality
- · Emotional impact / storytelling
- Visual clarity and potential for mural adaptation





Bonus points for:

- Thought-provoking or uplifting messages
- · Strong symbolism or story arc
- · Safe and empowering depictions of youth mental health

Selection Process:

- · Shortlist created from all submissions.
- · Top 3 winning artworks will directly influence the mural design.
- · Selected teens may be invited to help paint the lower section of the mural.

Key Dates:

- · Entries Open: Sunday 17 August 2025
- Entries Close: Friday 19 September 2025
- · Winners Announced: Early October 2025

Support & Safeguards:

- · Sensitive entries reviewed gently, with youth services support if needed.
- · Private submissions accepted via secure entry form or email.
